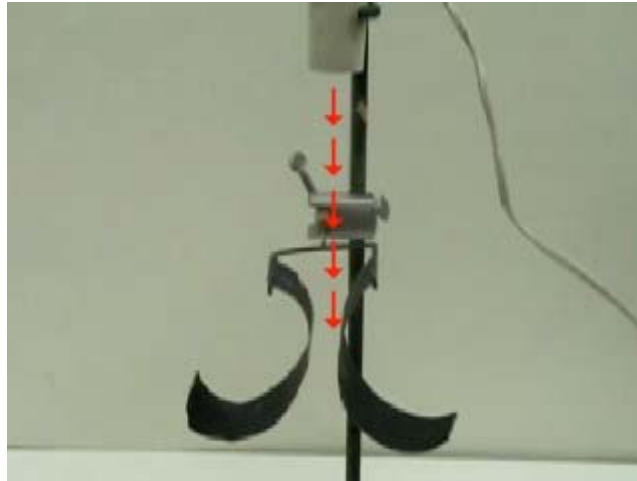


Question #346

The aluminum sheets from [Question #345](#) are now suspended adjacent to each other as seen in the photograph below, and the airstream is directed downward between the two sheets. The red arrows show the path of the center of the airstream, if it were to go straight through the two metal sheets, which may or may not be the case.
