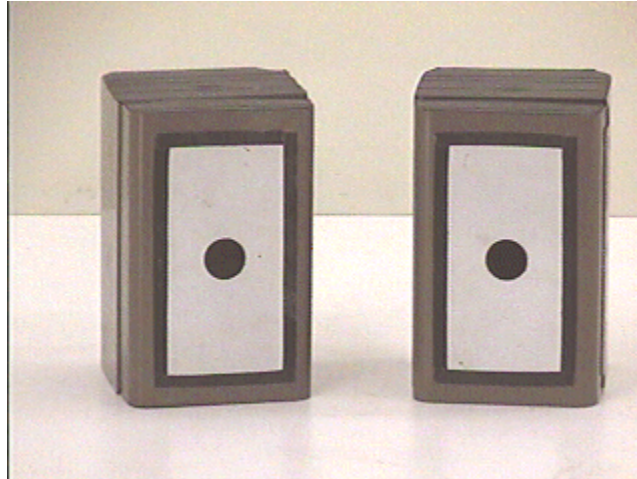


Question #93

Pictured below are two seemingly identical boxes, both painted white with black circles in the center of the white surface.



The question is, other than minor cosmetic differences, what might the difference between the two boxes be?

The difference between the two boxes is:
